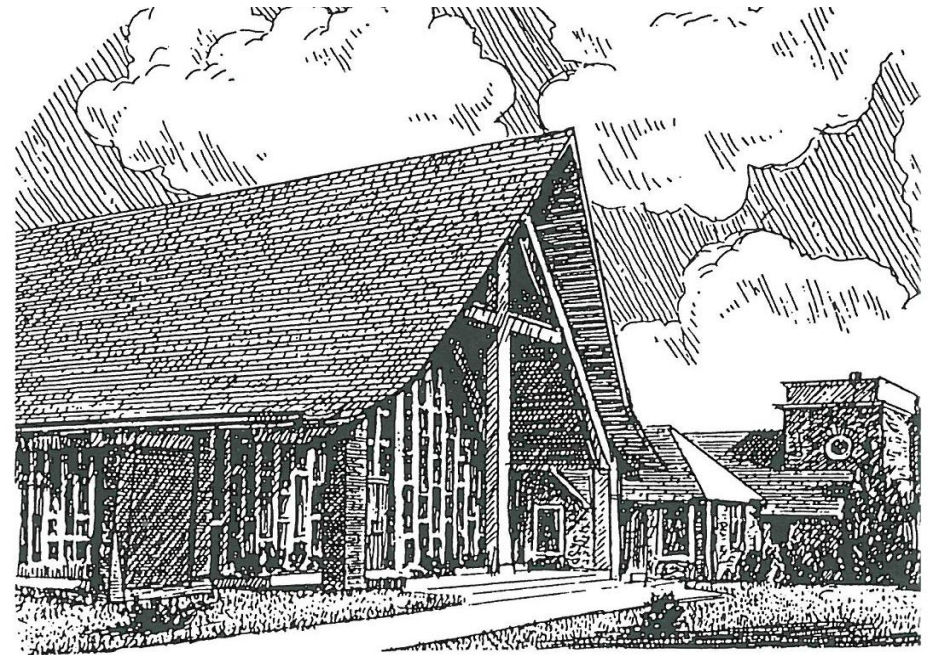
WE WELCOME ALL to this service of worship including newcomers and visitors among us.
